However, the following qualifications are desired: working knowledge of proper methods of serving food and the care of tableware, glassware, silver, and kitchen appliances; working knowledge of cleaning methods and the use of cleaning supplies and appliances; ability to follow simple oral and written directions; physical strength and stamina (able to lift 35# milk cases); be in good physical condition. Note: May travel to other buildings – transportation required.
Typical Work Activities:	Assist in cutting, washing, or otherwise preparing food items for cooking. Prepare simpler food items such as coffee, toast, eggs, juices, sandwiches, salads, etc. Loads and serves food at tables or from hot food trucks or on trays at assembly conveyor and/or serves food at cafeteria line as assigned. Arranges dishes, cutlery, napkins, sugar bowls, salt, and pepper shakers. Gathers used dishes, cutlery, and trays for washing; washes and sterilizes dishes, cutlery, trays, pots and pans. Cleans kitchen area and kitchen utensils.
