

## Mrs. Riggs's Grading \& Homework Policies

Grades are computed using the total points received out of the total possible points given in each quarter, and are comprised of:

Classwork: Cornell notes, graphic organizers, group/partner tasks
Homework: short answer responses to literature, vocabulary practice, independent reading reports

Tests: include various question types (mc, matching, etc.) and writing tasks
Essays: formal writing pieces that use the writing process, and timed tasks
Projects: presentations or tasks using other media
Participation: quickwrites (spiral notebook), on-time homeworks, ticket outs
*All students start each marking period with a free participation grade of 20 points (100\%). All you have to do is maintain it. Every time you miss a homework due date, you will lose 1 point (5\%) from your grade.
*Homework assignments can be made up while we are in the unit of study that they were assigned for. After that, they will remain a zero.
*Spiral notebooks used for quickwrites will be collected for a 100 point grade each marking period.
*Cornell Notes are valuable learning and study tools. They are worth 25 points each.
*Independent reading reports will be worth 30 points each ( 60 points per marking period).
