Boys' State is not a summer camp! Although there will designated recreation times, Boys' State is NOT a picnic -- NOT an outing--NOT a sports camp. Only young men with outstanding qualifications in leadership, character, scholarship, service and citizenship who will have a serious attitude toward an intensive citizenship training program will be selected.

PHYSICAL FITNESS is an integral part of Boys' State . There will be time set aside for a physical program to include calisthenics and marching to meals and assemblies to prepare for the parade which is one of the high points of the program.
