Goal: To promote an awareness and award students demonstrating an outstanding amount of civic activity and volunteer services.

Amount of the Award: A total of \$3,000 in scholarships to deserving students.

Eligibility: This scholarship is open to any Newfane High School graduating senior* who is a **current PTSA member** planning to continue their education at a two or four year college, trade school or technical training school. Membership forms are in the High School Main Office or you can join online at <https://newfaneptsa.memberhub.store>. Proof of enrollment to a school is required prior to receiving the scholarship funds. Financial status and academic achievement are not a factor for applying for this PTSA scholarship.

Deadline: Applications must be **postmarked** on or before **Monday, May 8th** addressed to **Newfane PTSA Scholarship Committee, c/o Sarah Bowman, 6171 Karen Ave, Newfane NY 14108** or **emailed & received by May 8th to sarahbowman2019@gmail.com**

Judging: Applications will be judged by the Newfane PTSA Scholarship Committee. No members of the committee will be the parent of an applicant or have an immediate relationship with an applicant.

Selection of the Winners: Recipients will be notified by Newfane High School to attend the Senior Award Night. A PTSA representative will present the award at the Awards Night. Checks will be mailed upon receipt of a class schedule or other proof of registration at a college, trade school or technical training school.
