Newfane to enhance safety with Raptor Visitor Management System

The District Safety Committee evaluated the Raptor visitor management system, and has unanimously recommended we adopt this program to enhance safety. Through this system,

all guests entering our buildings will:

- Present government issued ID such as a driver's license;
- Be screened on the national sex offender database registry;
- Have the date and time of their visit recorded;
- Wear a printed visitor ID badge.
- Note: employees will enter our buildings as they have in the past using their District ID/access card.

Roll-out of the program

- Communications to families will begin on February 1, 2024.
- A copy of the letter and an FAQ will be posted on our website in February.
- Training for administrators and those working the visitor management system (i.e. main office staff) will be trained on our March 8, 2024 Superintendent Conference Day.
- Reminder communications will be sent to families prior to spring break.
- Our new protocols will be implemented following the spring break on April 9, 2024.

As we refresh our website and move toward an integrated platform that includes parent communication, mass notification, and the ability to push content to social media platforms, stakeholder feedback has been sought:


- District Technology Committee reviewed and compared web providers, and selected ParentSquare as the finalist.
