SUPERINTENDENT REPORT:

<u>COVID-19 Update</u>: Mr. Baumann updated the board with the most recent information from the state regarding possible State Aid reductions; that Newfane is in compliance with district negotiated contracts relating to the 180 days of instruction; the Friday before Memorial Day will not be declared as a "day off" this year.

<u>Chrome Books</u>: Decisions are being made internally on collection, inventory system and sterilization of the Chrome Books that have been distributed to the students.

<u>Suggested by SED</u>: The State Education Department has made the suggestion that small districts think about possible mergers in the future.

<u>Budget Vote and Election</u>: A tentative date for the Annual Budget Vote and Election is June 9. The process and timeline is not determined as of now. <u>Student grading</u>: There is ongoing discussion with other districts and Newfane Administration about Final Grades for students. There is not a consensus at this time.

<u>Budget</u>: A couple local districts have adopted their 2020-2021 budgets and some others are waiting, expecting more information from the state on aid. The Board of Education discussed waiting to vote on the budget until the May 5, 2020 regular meeting date. (New Order of Business). Mr. Baumann presented the board with a summary of information shared over the past few months including revenue, expenses and future projections.

RESOLVED, A RESOLUTION, DATED APRIL 22, 2020, OF THE BOARD OF EDUCATION OF THE NEWFANE CENTRAL SCHOOL DISTRICT, NIAGARA COUNTY, NEW YORK (THE

"DISTRICT") DECLARING THE DISTRICT'S PROPOSED CAPITAL OUTLAY
PROJECT (INVOLVING MODEST UPGRADES AND IMPROVEMENTS AT THE
DISTRICT'S

MIDDLE SCHOOL GYMNASIUM) TO BE A TYPE II ACTION UNDER SEQRA, AND AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE INCLUSION OF FUNDING FOR SUCH PROJECT IN THE DISTRICT'S PROPOSED 2020-2021 BUDGET.

WHEREAS, the Newfane Central School District, Niagara County, New York (the "District"), after consultation by District officials with the District's selected architectural

firm (Cannon Design), has resolved that the District should propose to undertake, during the

District's pending (2020-2021) fiscal year, a capital outlay project involving modest upgrades

and improvements at the District's Middle School building, such work being anticipated to

include, but not necessarily to be limited to, the removal and replacement of the gymnasium

bleachers and wall pads, along with associated painting work (collectively, the "Project"); and

WHEREAS, the estimated maximum cost of the Project (inclusive of all preliminary and incidental costs) has been determined by Cannon Design to be \$100,000; and

WHEREAS, the District is proposing that the Project be financed by the application of \$100,000 of funds to be earmarked for such purpose as a "Transfer to Capital

Fund" in the District's pending (i.e., 2020-2021) budget, with the work on the Project expected

to be completed during the 2020-2021 fiscal year of the District; and WHEREAS, in accordance with State Education Department guidance and policy,

the District/Board of Education is the appropriate agency to be the lead agency to undertake

Project review under the State Environmental Quality Review Act ("SEQRA");

WHEREAS, the District wishes to reserve the right to expand, contract or modify

the scope of the Project in light of the level of future construction bids received, with the

understanding that the estimated maximum cost of the Project will not exceed \$100,000; and

WHEREAS, Section 617.5 of the SEQRA Regulations (6 NYCRR Part 617) provides that certain activities are Type II actions which are not subject to review under SEQRA

and that such activities include "routine activities of educational institutions," "maintenance or

repair involving no substantial changes in an existing structure or facility;" "replacement,

rehabilitation or reconstruction of a structure or facility, in kind, on the same site...unless such

action meets or exceeds any [Type I] thresholds in section 617.4"; and WHEREAS, the proposed Project constitutes such routine activities of educational institutions; maintenance or repair activities; and/or in-kind, same-site replacement,

rehabilitation or reconstruction activities not exceeding Type I thresholds; NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that it is the final determination of the District's Board of Education that the proposed Project is a Type II action, which is not subject

to review under SEQRA, and that the proposed Project will not result in a significant adverse

impact on the environment; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the proposed Project shall be included as a "Transfer to Capital

Fund" line item (not exceeding \$100,000 in amount) in the District's proposed budget for the

2020-2021 fiscal year (with appropriate additional notification to District voters regarding the anticipated details of the work to be given in connection with the District's regular budget presentation and approval process), so that such Project may be initiated and completed

(assuming voter approval of the District's proposed budget) during the District's 2020-2021

fiscal year; and be it further

RESOLVED, that this resolution shall take effect immediately.

TABLED

RESOLVED, that the General Fund Budget for the 2020-2021 school year of the Newfane Central School District shall be \$36,007,988 and that said amount shall be put forth before the District voters on a date to be determined by New York State, as Proposition 1.

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the proposed property tax report card and budget notice, which corresponds to the budget, adopted on April 22, 2020 for the 2020-2021 school year, be and is approved.
