SUPERINTENDENT REPORT:

Superintendent Baumann shared that he has been included in teacher google classrooms and found them to be wonderful. The Continuity of Learning plan was updated. The Instruction, connection and social emotional plans are working.

The NTA has donated \$1000 to foodservice programs and contributed gift cards for local families.

COVID-19 meeting update: It was shared from the Niagara County Health Director that there will not be gatherings before June 30, maybe the end of July. Keep in mind that there will most likely be a second resurgence. There will not be summer school or summer activities on campus. There is still a question if Fall athletics will take place. The O/N BOCES will place an order for PPE and the local districts can purchase through them.

The Budget Vote and Election will take place on June 9. All voting will be by absentee voting. The process is not fully developed yet.

Motion made by Trustee Casinelli and seconded by Trustee Oudette RESOLVED, A RESOLUTION, DATED MAY 5, 2020, OF THE BOARD OF EDUCATION OF THE NEWFANE CENTRAL SCHOOL DISTRICT, NIAGARA COUNTY, NEW YORK (THE "DISTRICT") DECLARING THE DISTRICT'S PROPOSED CAPITAL OUTLAY PROJECT (INVOLVING MODEST UPGRADES AND IMPROVEMENTS AT THE DISTRICT'S MIDDLE SCHOOL GYMNASIUM) TO BE A TYPE II ACTION UNDER SEQRA, AND AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE INCLUSION OF FUNDING FOR SUCH PROJECT IN THE DISTRICT'S PROPOSED 2020-2021 BUDGET.

Approved the Capital Project to be included in the 2020-2021 Budget.

WHEREAS, the Newfane Central School District, Niagara County, New York (the "District"), after consultation by District officials with the District's selected architectural firm (Cannon Design), has resolved that the District should propose to undertake, during the District's pending (2020-2021) fiscal year, a capital outlay project involving modest upgrades and improvements at the District's Middle School building, such work being anticipated to include, but not necessarily to be limited to, the removal and replacement of the gymnasium bleachers and wall pads, along with associated painting work (collectively, the "Project"); and

WHEREAS, the estimated maximum cost of the Project (inclusive of all preliminary and incidental costs) has been determined by Cannon Design to be \$100,000; and

WHEREAS, the District is proposing that the Project be financed by the application of \$100,000 of funds to be earmarked for such purpose as a "Transfer to Capital Fund" in the District's pending (i.e., 2020-2021) budget, with the work on the Project expected to be completed during the 2020-2021 fiscal year of the District; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with State Education Department guidance and policy, the District/Board of Education is the appropriate agency to be the lead agency to undertake Project review under the State Environmental Quality Review Act ("SEQRA"); and

WHEREAS, the District wishes to reserve the right to expand, contract or modify the scope of the Project in light of the level of future construction bids received, with the understanding that the estimated maximum cost of the Project will not exceed \$100,000; and

WHEREAS, Section 617.5 of the SEQRA Regulations (6 NYCRR Part 617) provides that certain activities are Type II actions which are not subject to review under SEQRA and that such activities include "routine activities of educational institutions," "maintenance or repair involving no substantial changes in an existing structure or facility;" "replacement, rehabilitation or reconstruction of a structure or facility, in kind, on the same site...unless such action meets or exceeds any [Type I] thresholds in section 617.4"; and WHEREAS, the proposed Project constitutes such routine activities of educational institutions; maintenance or repair activities; and/or in-kind, same-site replacement, rehabilitation or reconstruction activities not exceeding Type I thresholds;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that it is the final determination of the District's Board of Education that the proposed Project is a Type II action, which is not subject to review under SEQRA, and that the proposed Project will not result in a significant adverse impact on the environment; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the proposed Project shall be included as a "Transfer to Capital Fund" line item (not exceeding \$100,000 in amount) in the District's proposed budget for the 2020-2021 fiscal year (with appropriate additional notification to District voters regarding the anticipated details of the work to be given in connection with the District's regular budget presentation and approval process), so that such Project may be initiated and completed (assuming voter approval of the District's proposed budget) during the District's 2020-2021 fiscal year; and be it further

RESOLVED, that this resolution shall take effect immediately.

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Education of the Newfane Central School District:

- 1. THAT, the provisions of this resolution shall be effective regardless of anything to the contrary in the Board Policy Manual, or the previous minutes of this Board, or otherwise;
- 2. THAT, it is hereby determined, pursuant to Section 1716 of the Education Law, that the Annual Budget Hearing of this District, for presentation of the proposed 2020-21 school district budget, shall be adjourned and presented remotely June 1, 2020 as a video posted to the Public District Website.
- 3. THAT, pursuant to Section 2002 of the Education Law, the Annual Meeting and Election of the District shall be held on Tuesday, June 9, 2020 for the purpose of voting on the appropriation of the necessary funds to meet the District's estimated expenditures for the fiscal year commencing July 1, 2020, and ending June 30, 2021, for the purpose of electing two (2) members of the Board of Education and for the transaction of such other business as may be authorized by law.
- 4. THAT, all registered voters will receive absentee ballots via mail to include a postage paid return envelope, with a listing of persons to whom absentee ballots have been issued being available for inspection in the office

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, that a public hearing for the qualified voters of the Newfane Central School District for the presentation of the 2020-2021 budget, shall be adjourned and presented remotely, to be posted to the Public District Website immediately following.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, that the Annual District Meeting and Election of the qualified voters of the Newfane Central School District, Niagara County, New York, will be held on Tuesday, June 9, 2020 for the purpose of voting on the annual budget for the 2020-2021 fiscal year and electing two (2) members of the Board of Education for three (3) year terms commencing on July 1, 2020. All voting will be done via mail and absentee ballots. All registered voters will receive an absentee ballot to use for voting, anyone not receiving a ballot by May 27, 2020 should contact the District Clerk. TAKE FURTHER NOTICE, that the voting on the budget will consist of voting on the following propositions, as well as other such matters as may be lawfully presented at the meeting:

PROPOSITION NUMBER 1

Shall the following resolution be adopted to wit:

RESOLVED, that the budget of the Newfane Central School District (the "District"), Niagara County, New York, for the fiscal year commencing July 1, 2020 and ending June 30, 2021 as presented by the Board of Education, is hereby approved and adopted and the required funds therefore shall be hereby appropriated and the necessary real property taxes required shall be raised by a tax on the taxable property in said District to be levied and collected as required by law.

PROPOSITION NUMBER 2

Shall the following resolution be adopted to wit:

RESOLVED, that the Board of Education of the Newfane Central School District is hereby authorized to establish a Building Capital Reserve Fund pursuant to Section 3651 of the Education Law (to be known as the 2020 Building Capital Reserve Fund") with the purpose of such fund being to finance reconstruction, renovation and equipping of the High school, Middle school, Elementary school, Early Childhood Center and facilities, including the District athletic facilities, fields and track; pavements and grounds; fire suppression, phone and security systems; heating, plumbing, electrical and ventilation systems; structural repairs to doors, windows, floors and roofs; and other various improvements for energy efficiency and costs incidental thereto.

The ultimate amount of such fund is to be \$7,000,000.00, plus earnings thereon. The probable term of such fund is to be ten (10) years, but such fund shall continue in existence until liquidated in accordance with Education Law or until such funds are exhausted. The sources from which funds shall be obtained for such Reserve are: (i) amounts from budgetary appropriations from time to time; (ii) unappropriated fund balance made available by the Board of Education from time to time; and (iii) New York State Aid received and made available by the Board of Education from time to time; all as permitted by law.

TAKE FURTHER NOTICE, that the Board of Education of this District will have prepared and completed a detailed statement in writing of the amount of money which will be required during the 2020-2021 fiscal year for school purposes, specifying the several purposes and the amount for each. The amount for each purpose estimated necessary for payments to Boards of Cooperative Educational Services shall be shown in full, with no deduction of estimated state aid. The amount of state aid provided and its percentage relationship to the total expenditures shall also be shown. Such statement shall be completed at least seven days before the budget hearing at which it is to be presented and copies thereof shall be prepared and made available, upon request, to residents within the District during the period of seven days before the budget hearing and/or fourteen days immediately preceding the annual meeting and election, and may be obtained by any resident in the District at each school house in the District in which school is maintained as well as the District Office during normal business hours.

TAKE FURTHER NOTICE, that all candidates for the office of member of the Board of Education shall be self-nominated with the Clerk of the District. Each candidate must file the Candidate Certification of Nominating Petition form in the office of the Clerk of the District between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. weekdays but not later than 5:00 p.m. on the thirtieth day preceding the annual meeting and election, to wit, May 8, 2020. Board of Education candidates will be listed alphabetically on the ballot.

TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that the vote will be conducted entirely by Absentee Ballot. Absentee Ballots and a postage paid return envelope will be sent to all qualified voters in the district automatically. Absentee ballots must be received in the office the District Clerk not later than 5:00 p.m. prevailing time, on Tuesday, June 9, 2020. A listing of persons to whom absentee ballots have been issued will be available for inspection in the office of the District Clerk during each of the five days prior to day of the election, except Saturdays and Sundays.

- 6. That the District Clerk is hereby directed to arrange for the printing of ballots to be used, and each proposition to be submitted shall be so printed thereon in full with the words YES and NO so printed for each proposition.
