



"RJ is always kind to his classmates, and includes everyone in activities. When a new student transferred to Newfane last year RJ quickly befriended him and made him feel welcome."




"Kalynn has stayed after school almost daily with me for several weeks now to get caught up on English work, and has significantly raised her grade. Her perseverance has paid off :)"
